- You should submit your request by the due date on the reminder notice. If you paid the penalty before we sent a reminder notice, you should request to go to court within 90 days from the date the penalty was issued
- To transfer the penalty to the person responsible, name them online at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/mypenalty
- If you want us to review your penalty, please submit a request for review as well. We'll conduct a review and only list your matter for court if the outcome is unsuccessful
- **Print clearly using BLOCK LETTERS in the space provided**
- If all sections are not completed, **your application may not proceed**
- **Do not pay your fine before lodging this form**
- The Court may impose additional costs and will advise any amount and how to pay when your matter is decided.
