



Request to Have a Penalty Decided in Court – Individual

Note:

- You do not need to complete this form if you make your request online at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/fines/pn/court or you can return this form to Revenue NSW, PO Box 786, Strawberry Hills NSW 2012 or via email at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/contact
- We must receive your request by the due date on the reminder notice. If you paid the penalty before we sent a reminder notice, the deadline to request to go to court is 90 days from the date the penalty was served
- To transfer the penalty to the driver responsible, complete a statutory declaration at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/fines/pn/name
- If you want us to review your penalty, do not request to have the penalty decided in court. By law, we must stop any review if we receive a request to go to court. If your review is unsuccessful, you have 28 days to choose to have it decided in court
- **Print clearly using BLOCK LETTERS in the space provided**
- If all sections are not completed, **your application cannot be processed**
- **Do not pay your fine before lodging this form**
- The Court may impose additional costs and will advise any amount, and how to pay when the matter is decided.
